Policy: The Education Interest Network will develop policy briefs and work with AAIDD and other organizations (e.g., AUCD) to disseminate policy briefs that can impact policy and practice in key areas such as Medicaid cuts and its impact on students and adults with disabilities.

What impact does this practice have on students with the most significant needs and how are they included? The Interest Network will promote and facilitate the dissemination of research findings in these areas.

Communication: The Education Interest Network will enhance its communication to members and colleagues in the field by exploring the feasibility of developing a newsletter, establishing new networks, and expanding the website. The purpose of this goal is to make the Education Interest Network more visible and available to everyone.
