Objectives met

• Collaborate with other interest networks (met), support students (met), advance the field (met), promote the mission/goals/principles of AAIDD (met), and improve communication (met).

Activities completed (by June 30, 2018)

- The Student and Early Career Professionals Interest Network and the Research Interest Network jointly presented the 3rd annual SECP Research Colloquium held on June 25, 2018 as an AAIDD Pre-Conference session. There were presentations from 7 student researchers. Each presentation was followed by questions generated by the Research Interest Network Executive Committee. Subsequently, researchers in the audience provided further questions and feedback for the presenters. Following the presentations, a round table discussion was held. The session ended with informal networking among the students and researchers.
- The Research Division funded two scholarships for students to attend this year's AAIDD conference. The selection was made by the SECP Scholarship Committee and the scholarships were awarded to Jamie Pearson (North Carolina State University) and Allison D'Aguilar (Virginia Commonwealth University) at the SECP luncheon.
- The Research Interest Network hosted an AAIDD Research Webinar on December 7, 2017. The
 presenter was Dr. Sandy Magaña and the topic was "Health Equity Among Adults and Children with
 IDD from Diverse Backgrounds."
- At the Research Interest Network luncheon on June 27, 2017 members present reviewed the
 mission, goals, and principles of AAIDD as they pertain to research. Several RIN members objected
 to the wording of one of the principles. The RIN Executive Committee followed up, and ultimately
 the principle was removed on the AAIDD website.
- Seven announcements were shared with the 120 Research Interest Network members during the
 fiscal year. AAIDD provided regular membership updates to keep the email addresses current. The
 Research Interest Network Executive Committee met either by phone or electronically on a quarterly
 basis.
